VINTAGE NOTE

The 2019 vintage was surprising and challenging, but also presented wonderful opportunities to make compelling, memorable wines. The winter was initially mild, but late and heavy snowfall delayed the start of the growing season. Spring was moderately cool and wetter than average. Summer was similarly cooler than average with few days exceeding 95'F, even during the typically hot months of July and August. Harvest began several weeks later than average, but the fruit had a sense of tension and freshness not seen in warmer years (early-ripening varieties such as Chardonnay benefited most).
