A delicious treat, this half bottle comes in a shiny gift box, provides many servings, and you can so pour it over ice cream if you want to indulge in an intoxicating desert.

#### DOMAINE DE LA RIVIÈRE-2017 N REACH VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR | \$75

Domaine de la Rivière's [domaineriviere.com] very limited roduction pinot (only 135 cases) complex, full-bodied, elegant, lky, balanced and gently spiced. It eceives high scores, is made by a very small producer and will almost definitely make a lasting impression on even the most educated wine

# DUSLEY BRANDY | \$45

going to break the bank

The Housley family (housleynapavalley.com) has been in the Bay Area for six generations and Napa Valley for over 50 years. And while their focus is wine, they have "come to love a good brandy" and chosen to use Napa grapes and work with Napa Valley Distillery on their brandy to keep things local and pay homage to their Bay Area roots. It's unique, made from wine grapes, and you can visit Housley in Napa and meet the makers.

#### **BV PRIVATE RESERVE GEORGES** DE LATOUR CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY | \$145

Most wine drinkers have heard the name BV (bywines.com) and have likely seen bottles everywhere from the local market to the reserve list at their favorite steakhouse. Since BV wines are extremely diverse and wellknown, this is not the right wine for a wine snob. But it is the perfect gift for a new collector, and those who appreciate history and aren't stuck on boutique brands. Whatever the case may be, this wine is as good as good gets, so give it with pride.

# CABERNET SAUVIGNON | \$275

Iridium is one of the rarest metals on Earth and Iridium cabernet is extremely limited and the rarest wine made by Sterling Vineyards (sterlingvineyards.com/iridium). This Napa Valley winery is fun to visit because it has expansive views and you get to ride an aerial tram. And this bottle is shiny, heavy, beautiful and bold; its heft is known to provoke a lively reaction.

# TOYMAKER CELLARS "TOY CHEST"

## \$1,200

If you're really looking to impress, reach out directly to the winery (info@toymakercellars.com); ask for Steven; and reserve one of only 25 beautiful limited-edition chests containing four vertical vintages (2012-15) of Toymaker. This Napa

Valley Diamond Mountain cabernet sauvignon will impress anyone. It's on theme, and the wood boxes are handcrafted by Work Training Center Inc., who provides job and life skills to adults with developmental disabilities.

## CORAVIN MODEL ONE | \$200

This killer little device from Coravin (coravin.com) draws wine out of the bottle without popping the cork and replaces it with a gas that keeps the rest fresh in the bottle. So you can sample a bottle from your collection to find out if its ready, enjoy just a glass of your most coveted vino or debunk the "don't want the bottle to go to waste" excuse for drinking more.

# NE DECANTER | \$49-\$499

There are a million different wine decanters, and they range in size, shape and price and do the same thing: aerate your wine. The air smooths out rough edges and makes intense wines more drinkable Choose your decanter based on style and avoid squares and rectangles. And if they don't use it for wine, they can always use it as a vase!
