VINEYARDS

Benton Hills Vineyards lies in a premier wine region of southeastern Washington, defined by arid, southwest-sloping hills that host some of the Columbia Valley's most celebrated vineyards. Dr. Walter Clore, often called the "father" of Washington wine, recognized the site's gentle, south-facing slopes and warm temperatures, encouraging row orientation to maximize sun exposure and planting in small blocks. These estate vineyards are sustainably farmed and managed for low yields through careful pruning and thinning, resulting in evenly ripened fruit and wines that are consistently ripe, rich, and fruit-forward.

TASTING NOTE

Our red wine blend opens with rich aromas of black cherry, ripe plum, and blackberry. The palate is broad and dense, layering juicy dark berries, plum, and black cherry across a plush, rounded texture. Fine tannins bring focus, carrying the concentrated fruit into a long finish of blackberry, dark cherry, and ripe plum.

WINEMAKING

Benton Hills Red Wine blends fruit from our premier blocks, showcasing the tremendous range of red wine styles Washington and Goose Gap can produce. Each wine was vinified separately to manage fermentation to create the optimal balance of structure, freshness, and richness in the wine. Malolactic fermentation was completed on oak to enhance softness and sweetness. The wine matured for 12 months before bottling.
